Students may sign up for more than one class, but students may not sign up for classes that conflict with previous commitments (band, orchestra, honor choir, after school art class). Class size is limited; therefore, enrollment will occur on a first-come, first-served basis. These classes are quarter based and may not be offered again in future quarters.

- Parents or students may line up to turn in the forms. The office will number the forms in order that they receive them. When the class is full, students may be put on a waiting list for classes to be offered other quarters
  - Being put on a waiting list does not guarantee the student will participate in a future class. Classes may or may not be offered in future quarters. Students on the waiting list will be contacted if the class is offered again in order to have priority for signing up.
